



## IDAHO STATE TRUCK FLEET SAFETY AWARDS

### **RULES:**

1. The contest year is **April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018.**
2. The contest is open to companies of all sizes including small owner/operators. The applicant must be a member company of the Idaho Trucking Association.
3. Only "Idaho" miles will be counted toward the fleet safety awards.
4. Errors, falsification or incomplete information on the entry form will eliminate the applicant from the contest.
5. Companies must disclose all reportable crashes which occurred in Idaho during the contest period (April 1, 2017 – March 31, 2018), regardless of fault.

*A reportable accident is defined by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulation, Part 390: "an occurrence involving a commercial motor vehicle operating on a public road which results in: (i) a fatality; (ii) bodily injury to a person who, as a result of the injury, immediately receives medical treatment away from the scene of the accident; or (iii) one or more motor vehicles incurring disabling damage as a result of the accident, requiring the vehicle to be transported away from the scene by a tow truck or other motor vehicle."*

6. The Safety Awards Selection Committee will review all entries to confirm CSA scoring and crashes reported.
7. Applications must be submitted on this official entry form and be legible in order to be considered for the award.
8. The Safety Awards Selection Committee will choose a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner in each mileage category, and an overall Grand Champion, using the criteria described herein.
9. Submission deadline is: **June 10, 2018.**

### **THE GRAND CHAMPION TROPHY**

To be considered for the Grand Champion Trophy, include a synopsis/summary (1 page or less) of your safety program and its successes along with this application.

*The committee will not accept safety manuals or procedure booklets in place of the 1 page summary.*

**A truck fleet is ineligible to win the Grand Champion Trophy if they have won the Grand Champion Trophy in the last **three** contest years.**

*(Safety Awards Selection Committee use only)*

All completed applications submitted prior to the deadline will be scored using the following criteria. It is the intent of the safety awards program to provide a level playing field for all carriers, regardless of size. Innovation and significant safety program improvements may also be used to determine award winners, but only if documentation is provided.

All scoring will be done assuming an accurate, completed and timely application, which is worth 50 points. Point scores may or may not be the final determining factor in choosing the winners. All relevant information submitted will be considered.
